Walk

Avion Burbank has seven (7) on-site bike parking locations noted by the bike icons on the site directory.

The Burbank Airport North Metrolink Station has 6 bicycle lockers available for rent. The lockers are free to use, but registration is required. To register, contact the City of Burbank at nburant@burbankca.gov or (818) 238-5290.
